# Safeguarding Adults in Berkshire Important Contact Details – updated 2022

## 1. Is the adult in immediate danger?

If yes, contact the Police on 999

The Police can be contacted 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year.

# 2. For all other referrals about an adult living in Reading contact the Local Authority Safeguarding Adults team

An adult is a person aged 18 years and over. Contact the Adult Social Care team in the area in in which the person lives on:

You can contact this number as a professional for advice or guidance around situations or incidents that you are concerned about. This is to support safeguarding practice decision-making and to ensure information relating to the support someone needs is sent to the correct team(s) to avoid delay.

#### 3. Do you need to contact Children's Safeguarding?

Contact Children's Single Point of Access (CSPA) if:

- the safeguarding referral is about a person under 18 or if they are under 25 and have special needs; or
- there are children or young people who may be affected by the incident, such as children living in the same home.
