

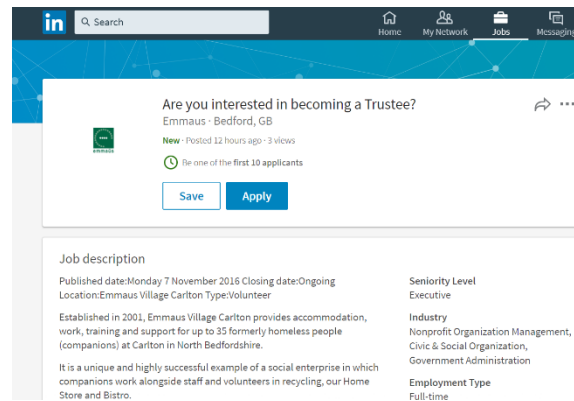


How to use LinkedIn to recruit trustees

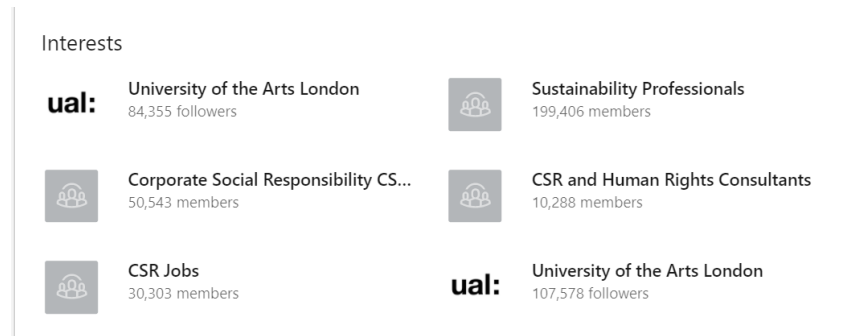

4. **Professional and interest groups.** Scroll to the bottom of someone's profile to see their interests and groups (pick someone who has a similar profile to the person you are looking to recruit). You can then message the administrator of the group to ask them to share the vacancy.



5. **Search people who want voluntary board experience** – click in the “search” box and select “people”, then “All filters”. Click “Board service” as one of the options, as well as the skills/experience you are looking for.
